

## MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SYLACAUGA HELD OCTOBER 19, 2021

1. Meeting was called to order at 6:07 P.M. by Council President, Lee Perryman.

3. Invocation was provided by Pastor Brian Jones, First Assembly of God.
4. Council President Perryman led the group in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.
